About the health checkup

The University conducts annual health checkups for all year levels.

These check-ups have various essential purposes, such as:

- ☆ The early detection of diseases
- ☆ To promptly provide medical support in school
- ☆ To provide health education to maintain the health of students

Health checkups are mandatory based on the School Health and Safety Act.



Contents of Health Checkup

Height and weight

Urine
(sugar, protein)

Blood pressure

Chest X-ray

Eye sight

Physical examination

Blood analysis

Liver function, serum lipid concentration, blood glucose, hemoglobinA1c, uric acid, antibody tests for measles, rubella, mumps, and chicken pox.



These health checkups are free.

Health certificates (Japanese, English) for use in practical training and studying abroad will be issued using the health checkup data at no charge.

Venue

- ☆ Your body temperature will be measured using a non-contact thermometer at the health checkup reception desk.
- ☆ Please enter the chest x-ray examination bus one by one.
- ☆ Please maintain a safe distance when you line up.

Proceed to the Health Administration Center counter, and make an appointment for later date for your health checkup which is also free of charge.

Confirmation of results

Retrieve your health check-up results online (Academic Affairs Information System) at a later date. A hard copy of the results will not be distributed. For those who have items that need to be re-examined, please proceed to the Health Administration Center by the end of September.
